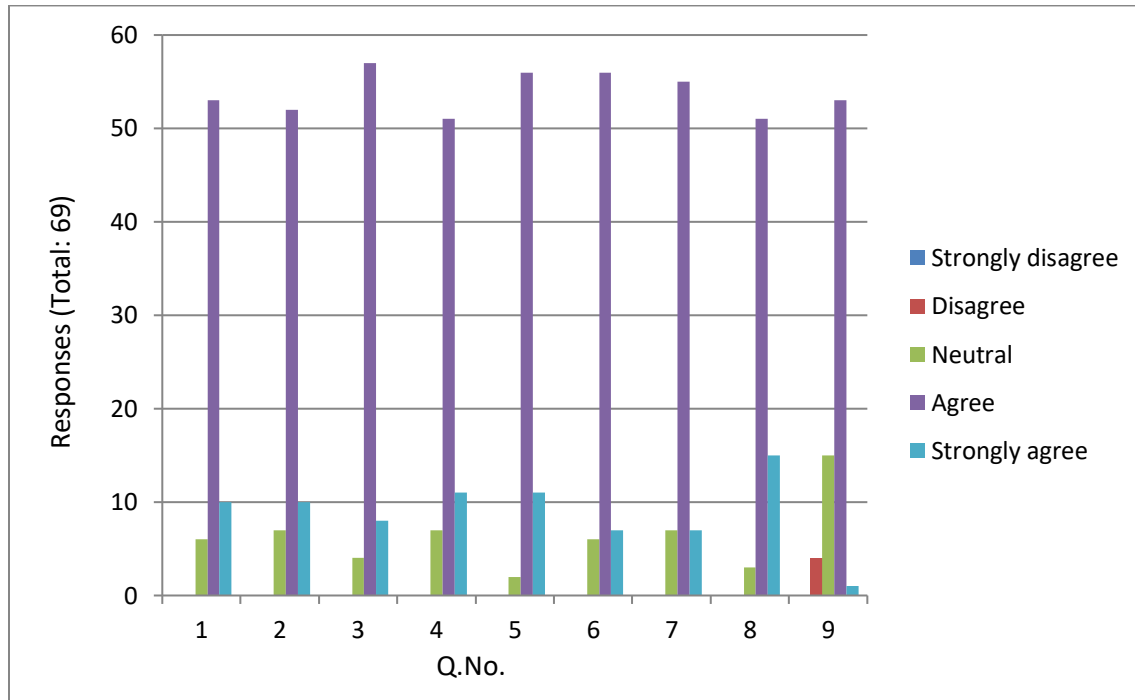
To gather feedback, forms were circulated to parents at the end of the even semester. The IQAC was responsible for distributing and collecting these forms.
