



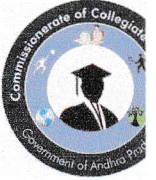

Outcome: Articles 29 and 30 ensure that religious and linguistic minorities can preserve their distinct culture and establish their own educational institutions without state discrimination.





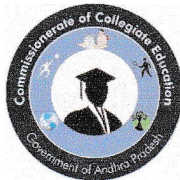
